White Wines

5 **Colombard Chardonnay** - Duc de Chapelle (France)
The fresh, crisp citrusy Colombard has been added to the rounder, fuller flavoured Chardonnay giving a dry white with complexity, structure & an ideal balanced palate.

6 **Pinot Grigio** - Portenova, Veneto (Italy)

This fashionable white has a touch of Chardonnay added to give extra weight & complexity. The aroma is delicate & zingy. On the palate there are hints of nuts & lovely ripe fruit flavours.

7 **Sauvignon Blanc** - La Playa, Colchagua Valley (Chile)

Highly aromatic wine with strong notes of citrus fruits & flowers together with a pleasant subtle touch of fresh grass & ripe pineapples. Ideal with shellfish, steamed or grilled fish.

8 **Piesporter Michelsberg** - Schmitt Sohne (Germany)

A beautifully fragrant, medium bodied wine with up front fruit that continues to develop on the palate. Hints of peaches & green apples that are balanced perfectly with crisp acidity to give it a clean, fresh finish.

9 **Semillon Chardonnay** - Copperstone Creek (Australia)
Golden straw in colour, this wine displays lifted tropical & zesty lemon flavours, with hints of white peach & pineapple characters. The palate is clean, crisp & balanced by lively citrus notes & superb acidity that leads to a persistently long finish.

10 **Chenin Blanc** - Backsberg, Paarl (South Africa)

The bouquet has hints of vanilla & an almost oaky character. Enticing peach, apricot, lemon lead into a fruity mouthful where more tropical flavours add complexity.

11 **Sauvignon Blanc** - Esk Valley, (New Zealand)

Wine maker Gordon Russell creates some of the finest wines of the Hawkes Bay region of North Island. Extra ripeness give his Sauvignon Blanc richness & elegance on the palate with passion fruit flavours & refined citrus acidity.

12 **Chablis** - Domaine Alain Gautheron (Burgundy)

A very traditional Chablis; fresh & floral with apple fruit & a complex, rich mineral character. Fermentation & maturation avoids wood to preserve the fresh steely flavours & unique influence of the chalky vineyard soils.

13 **Sancerre** - Domaine Crochet (Loire Valley)

Delightful elegant & classic Sancerre with a grassy aroma & well balanced ripe flavours of apple & elderflower. Whilst rich with citrus flavours it has excellent balance & weighty fruit on the palate.

15 **Wild Rush Rosé** - Rietvallei Estate, Robertson (South Africa)

This rosé is made made 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. The wine has a lovely floral bouquet with intense berry fruit flavours on the palate & a long-lasting aftertaste. A fresh, fruity dry wine for everyday enjoyment.

14 **Pinot Grigio 'Ramato'** - Il Barco, Veneto (Italy)

It has the delicate perfumed aroma of peach & rose petals & soft, red fruit flavours on the palate. It is dry & well balanced, excellent to drink with fish & white meats.

Red Wines

- 16 Cabernet Merlot** - Duc de Chapelle (France)
Modern techniques & vinification have produced this bright red wine which retains the natural fresh fruit character. This Cabernet Merlot is soft & mellow with ripe berry flavours & is smooth in the mouth.

- 17 Merlot Carmenère** - Los Caminos, Colchagua Valley (Chile)
A vibrantly fruity blend of three of Chile's prestige red varieties. The palate is rich with plum & red berry flavours with a hint of earthy mineral character & a firm structure.

- 18 Shiraz Cabernet** - Copperstone Creek (Australia)
Vibrant plum red colour, this wine presents aromas of lifted dark berry characters, supported by hints of chocolate & coconut flavours. The intensity & structure of the Cabernet & the spicy fruit richness of the Shiraz combine to make a wine that is easily enjoyable with good length.

- 19 Chianti Classico** - La Lellera, Castello Vicchiomaggio (Italy)
This fine estate Chianti Classico has enticing cherry, herbs & bitter fruits on the nose. It is full bodied, with good fresh fruit, a touch of oak & a bittersweet finish that makes it drink particularly well with food.

- 20 Pinotage** - Backsberg, Paarl (south Africa)
A perfect balance between old & new vines gives the wine soft focused mulberry fruit. Excellent with cold meats, grilled dishes & cheeses.

- 21 Rioja Crianza** - Bodegas Azabache (Spain)
The young winemaker (recently arrived from Faustino) makes a Crianza that is richly fruity, restrained by careful yet traditional oak aging (12 months in American & french oak) & represents fantastic value. It is bright a bright red colour, full-bodied & rounded with a long finish.

- 22 Merlot** - La Playa, Colchagua Valley (Chile)
Good aromatic intensity & richness of ripe dark vine fruits, blackberries & blackcurrants. Soft tannins & gentle flavours complete the package of this truly ripe varietal Merlot wine.

- 23 Château Tanesse** - Premières Cotes de Bordeaux 2000
This has classic structure &, in this great vintage, it has extra depth of soft fruit with subtle oak, ripe tannins & an excellent balance. Blended from 60% Cabernet Sauvignon & 40% Merlot.

Champagne

- 1 Lenoble** - Brut Reserve NV (Epernay)
This is an elegant Champagne with a dominance of Grand Cru Chardonnay from the Côte des Blancs providing soft nutty flavour with fine bubbles & a fruity nose. It is fresh, light, lively & well balanced on the palate with a long satisfying flavour.

- 2 Taittinger** - Brut Reserve NV (Reims)
Pale straw colour with a consistent & fine mousse. The nose is light & delicate with hints of biscuit & brioche. The palate is lean, but has considerable depth & is elegant with a long fresh finish.

- 3 Mailly Grand Cru** - Rose NV (Reims)
This is a delightful salmon pink Champagne from an exceptional 'mono cru' producer using 75% Pinot Noir grapes & 25% Chardonnay. This prestige rosé is made by the technique known as 'saignee' or bleeding of the juice rather than the simple addition of red wine used for the vast majority of rosé Champagnes. It has an elegant summer fruits bouquet with strawberry & mineral nuances on the palate.

Sparkling Wine

- 4 Duc de Chapelle** - Brut. Cuvee Close NV (France)
A 'méthode cuve close' (or naturally fermented in vat) sparkling Chardonnay, Colombard & Ugni Blanc blend from France. This style of crisp, fruity sparkling wine is elegant, well balanced with a fresh, melon & apple flavours.
